Guidelines:

- Writers, producers and directors **must** apply as an individual. The selected applicants will be encouraged to form successful working partnerships with the other candidates during the development phase;
- The writer, director and producer may **not** be the same person. Applicants may apply for various roles however you will only be selected for one of these roles;
- A writer may submit a maximum of two screenplays;
- Screenplays may be **no longer** than 12 pages and **must** be in industry standard format.
- Screenplays may be in the English or Irish language;
- Writers must submit a signed declaration of ownership of all materials. This is a document stating that the screenplay submitted is your original work.
- Producer and directors personal statement may be no longer than 1 page.
- Applicants must be 18 years of age or over;
- Students in full time education are **not** eligible to apply;
- Incomplete or late applications will **not** be accepted;
- Please note that we aim to achieve gender balance across the selected teams.

- A 10 minute screenplay with the story title on each page but **NOT** your name (PDF format)
- A logline (max 25 words) (PDF format)
- Synopsis (max 300 words) (PDF format)
- A signed declaration of ownership of all materials submitted (PDF format)
- One page CV containing relevant experience (biographies will **not** be accepted) (PDF format)
- Completed application form (PDF format)
- Entry fee for a writer is €5.00. Entry fee covers one script per person (payment details are below).
